

According to the Federal Election Commission, contributions to DECPAC cannot be deducted as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 per calendar year. Contributions to DECPAC are for political purposes. Contributions are voluntary, and you have the right to refuse to contribute without reprisal. The maximum contribution amount allowed by law is \$5,000 per year. You will not be favored or disadvantaged by reason of the amount you contribute or your decision not to contribute.
